SUBJECT: Reporting Credentials in SKIES for WIA Programs

The following Actual Outcome values in the Service(s) Plan/Service screen will result in a credential count:

- Attained High School Diploma
- Attained GED/HS Equivalency
- Associated Degree Earned
- Bachelors Degree Earned
- Occupational Skills License
- Occupational Skills Certificate/Credential*

The following selections in the Degree list of values in the Education Assessment – Education History screen or in the Core Services Education/Skills – Certificates/Education History screen will result in a credential count:

- High School Graduate
- GED/High School Equivalent
- Associates Degree
- Bachelors Degree
- Masters Degree
- Doctorate Degree
- Occupational Skills License
- Occupational Skills Certificate/Credential*

Degrees or certificates are counted if they are obtained during participation and up through the end of the third quarter after exit.

*Includes

- Completed a program on the Eligible Training Provider List
- or
- Accredited college/apprenticeship program
