

COMMUNITY PARTNER FRONT LINE STAFF PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING

The WDC is collaborating with Training, Analysis & Development (TAD) Grants to offer professional development training opportunities for front-line staff. The training will be conducted over a 14-week period and will follow a hybrid format, combining online learning (weekly live Zoom sessions) with 2 day in-person sessions. The program is designed to equip participants with the knowledge and skills required to excel in their roles and make a meaningful impact on workforce development. As of November, there were 28 staff from 7 subcontractor partners enrolled in the training.

Upon successful completion and mastery of the Workforce and Career Development Certification (WCDC) curriculum, including adequate completion of all assignments and demonstration of required participation, participants will receive a Certificate of Completion and can apply for the certifications listed below —

- Certified Workforce Development Professional (CWDP)
- Certified Career Services Provider (CCSP)
- Global Career Development Facilitator (GCDF)
